POLICY 5475 STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Students with disabilities shall conform to the policies set forth by the School Board.

The Board recognizes that the needs manifestest thoughests with disabilities dictate a high level of understanding and consideration. To accomplish seweth of understanding anadipport, various program models shall be developed such as: special seched classes, resource rooms, and itinerant services. These program models will be utilized within the following general guidelines:

- x The special school model can only be used for the severely disabled student and only when the total educational environment of the students the controlled as determined by the IEP. Exceptions to existing District policies, rules are regulations may be made by the Board upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools.
- x When special educations are programmed into general education classes, they will be expected to conform with the same policies and regulations as other students except as determined by the Individual Education Program (I.
