POLICY 4332 CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS

To ensure the safety and wbbing of students and staff, a criminal background check shall be conducted for all persons recommended for employment with KUSD.

Likewise, all visitors will either complete a iminal background check or comply with all visitor management processes and procedures. KUSD requires all individuals who will be unsupervised and/or have little to no staff oversight while having direct access to students to complete a criminal backgrou check. Examples include tutors, mentors, volunteers, chaperones and ot Kets Distaff who will be responsible for the safety and whereing of students. If an individual serving in this capacity can establish that they are subject to a criminal background of FKHFN DW OHDVW DV H[WHQVLY] will be considered (e.g. police and fire personnel). The district requires all other visitors who will have staff-supervised access to students (e.g. guest speakers, parent helpers, etc.) duringurstool adhere to all current visitor management processes and procedures, including checking in at the front RILLFH 7KH SULQFLSDO RU WKH SULQFLSDO TV GHVLJQHH KDV V and to determine what conditionsaifly, will apply to the visit.

Information from criminal background checks will not be used or considered in making employment or volunteerism decisions unless a past conviction or circumstance giving rise to a pending charge is substantially related to
