RULE 5431.1 SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Site councils, parent organizations,d/or site committees must express an interest in adopting a uniform style dress code for students. A parent survey wildown ducted. The survey must state that the cost of the program will be incurred by parents/guardialns simple majority of parent respondents to the survey support a uniform style dress code for sttsdeach school site will develop procedures to initiate the program.

The following criteria is to be included in the procedures for program implementation.

- 1. Compliance with the program must be voluntary.
- 2. The initial program will be in effect for two consecutive years whereupon it will be evaluated by the site committee with a recommendation of continuance or discontinuance.
- 3. Programs will be initiated at the beginning of the school year and parents must be notified of the procedures prior to the end of the preceding school year.
- 4. Where feasible, school sites will facilitate the purchase and resale of school uniforms.

A copy of the school site plan for implementation of a uniform style dress code for students will be submitted to the Superintendent/designee program prior to the initiation of the program.
